Temporary Road Closure – McFarlane Street Bridge

Trent-Severn Waterway National Historic Site

Peterborough, Ontario, July 7th, 2017 –The McFarlane Street Bridge in Peterborough, Ontario will be closed to traffic between the hours of 9:00 am and 2:30 pm, on July 18th, 2017. In the case of inclement weather or if work cannot be completed on the 18th, the closure could be extended into the 19th during the same hours.

The temporary closure will allow workers to repair and replace the guide rails on the approaches to the bridge.

Alternate routes across the Trent-Severn Waterway canal include the Maria Street Swing Bridge, Warsaw Road Swing Bridge, through the Peterborough Lift Lock tunnel, and Lansdowne Street East.

Through investments in infrastructure, Parks Canada is protecting and preserving our treasured places, while supporting local economies, contributing to growth in the tourism sector, and enhancing the charm and attractiveness of Canada's heritage sites.
