Terms

Requests for filming or photography will be processed in the two weeks following their reception at *info.fortifications@pc.gc.ca*. Once the request has been approved, a letter of agreement will be sent to the requester. This will serve as a permit for the use of Parks Canada grounds for filming or photography.

Conditions

- The request (including a duly completed form and the required accompanying documents) must be submitted at least 15 business days before the date of the filming or photography session. Parks Canada reserves the right to refuse requests that do not adhere to this deadline.
- Parks Canada's fees for filming and photography rights vary according to the size of the production team, the length of the filming or photography session, and the content and its primary use. These fees include the cost of the request and the cost of using the grounds.
- The requester will receive a breakdown of the costs as soon as the request has been accepted. These fees must be paid within 30 days of reception of the invoice, which will be sent in the days following the filming or photography session.
- To cancel, the requester must notify Parks Canada in writing at least 24 hours before the planned filming or photography date, or the full fees will be invoiced. Processing fees are not refundable.
- A proof of liability insurance (2 million dollar minimum) is required **before** the planned filming or photography session.
